It also has outstanding catches of Largemouth Bass, Smallmouth Bass, Channel Catfish, Crappie, Bluegill and Perch.

Be at the church at 6:00 P.M. to load your gear into your assigned car. We will be leaving at 6:30 P.M., sharp, on Friday night, from the Community Presbyterian Church parking lot.
