General Description:

We will explore the cave Saturday afternoon and evening. The cave is lit and has trails and rock formations to climb on. For the more adventurous, there are smaller "trails" that you crawl through on your belly! These trails are totally dark and you will need a headlamp. We will sleep in the cave on the ground. The cave can be damp and drip water, so a sheet of plastic or a small tarp is recommended to put under and over you. Temperature in the cave is about 52 degrees. We are limited to 30 people of which 5 or 6 need to be drivers.

We will meet at the Church on Saturday morning at 7:30am to load up and depart at 8:00am. Please do not be late! We will not stop to eat.
