WHEN:	January 31 through February 2, 2003
WHERE:	We'll be staying at BSA Camp Napowan in cabins. Our activity is at Nordic Mountain Ski Area, near Wild Rose, Wisconsin. Its phone number is 1-800-253-7266.
DEPART:	We will leave from the Community Presbyterian Church parking lot, on Elmhurst at 6:30 PM sharp on Friday the 31st. We will stop at McDonald's, just north of Milwaukee for a quick meal on the way up.
COST:	The total cost of food, lodging, transportation, and ski/snowboarding is to be paid by Thursday, January 16th . Please refer to the schedule below. You must bring additional money if you want any meals or snacks on the road or at the ski lodge.
ACTIVITY:	Ski/Snowboarding will be all day and evening on Saturday, February 1st.

DOWNHILL SKIING/SNOWBOARDING

Downhill skiing and snowboarding will be at Nordic Mountain, about 2 miles from Napowan. You can bring your own skis or ski equipment rental is available. You must also pay for a "lift ticket" in order to use the facilities. See the rates on the sign up sheet attached. All scouts will be required to take the ski lesson unless excused (in writing) by a parent.

PERSONAL EQUIPMENT

Of course bring clothes that will keep you warm, e.g. jacket, hat, long johns, sweater, wool socks. Do not bring loose items like scarves. Beginners should bring some old leather gloves or obtain leather work gloves from Dad because the beginners lift, called a rope tow, will ruin other gloves. Nylon, vinyl or knit gloves do not provide the protection needed. Bring dry clothes to change into after skiing, and of course, **you will need your "travel uniform" going to and coming back from Napowan.** The cabins have bunks, showers, flush toilets and a kitchen so just bring your personal gear, sleeping bag, eating utensils and a cup.

You can work on the Winter Sports Merit Badge while on this outing. Get the book, look over the "orals" and we will help you with the skiing/snowboarding part on this outing.

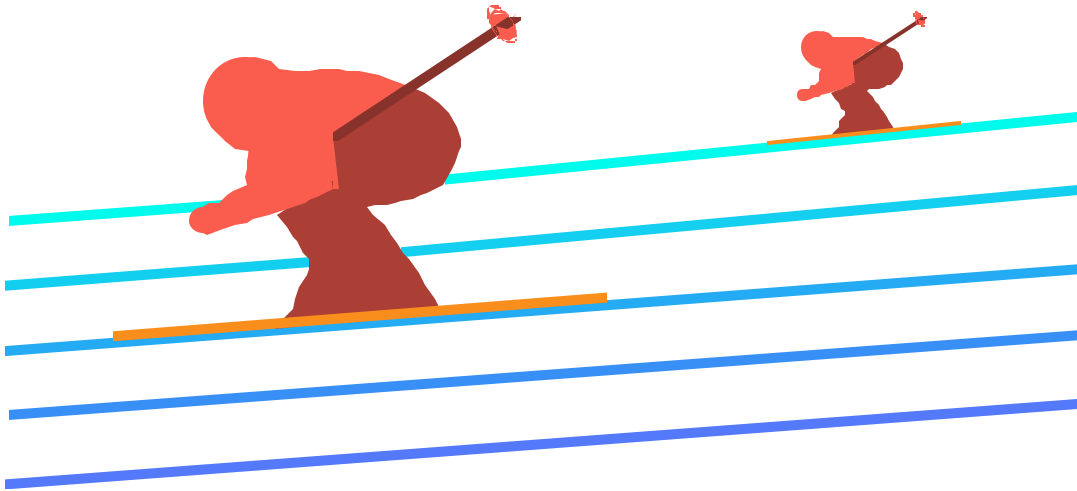
RETURN
